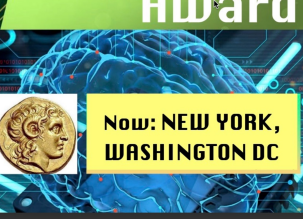

EVENT STRUCTURE IN NEW YORK
